## A resident PCN cancellation policy is included as part of the current service agreement as per the following terms and conditions:

- The right to have one PCN cancelled per property without charge for parking without a valid physical permit displayed in the windscreen of the vehicle if parked within a residential marked bay only.
- If the marked bays are allocated this will ONLY be accepted if the vehicle was parked in the allocated bay intended for use by the resident in question.
- The resident cancellation policy is to ONLY benefit those residents and tenants of the development with a right to park on the development.
- The cancellation policy does not apply to any property that does not hold a parking right.
- The cancellation policy does not apply to non-resident vehicles i.e. visitors.
- The cancelation policy also does not apply to a vehicle parked in any visitor bays or communal areas that are not for use in terms of parking.
- The PCN must be raised with Parking Control Management (UK) Ltd within the first 14 days of issue.
